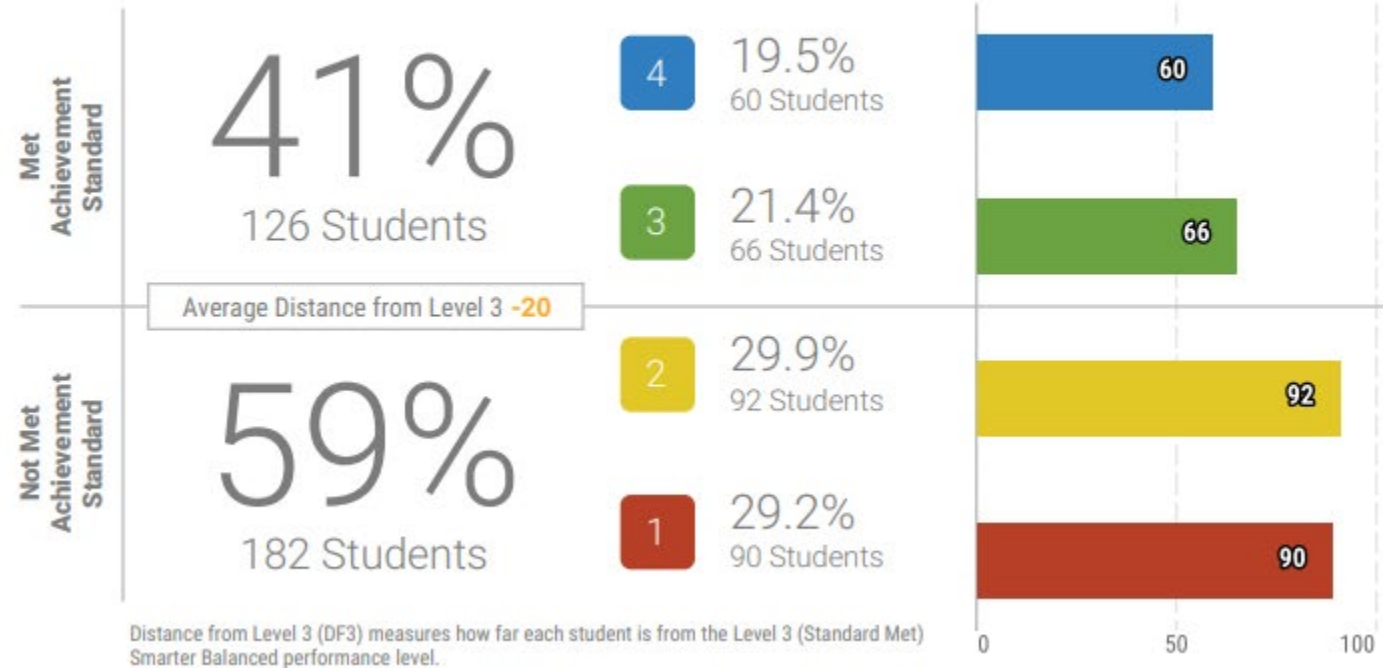

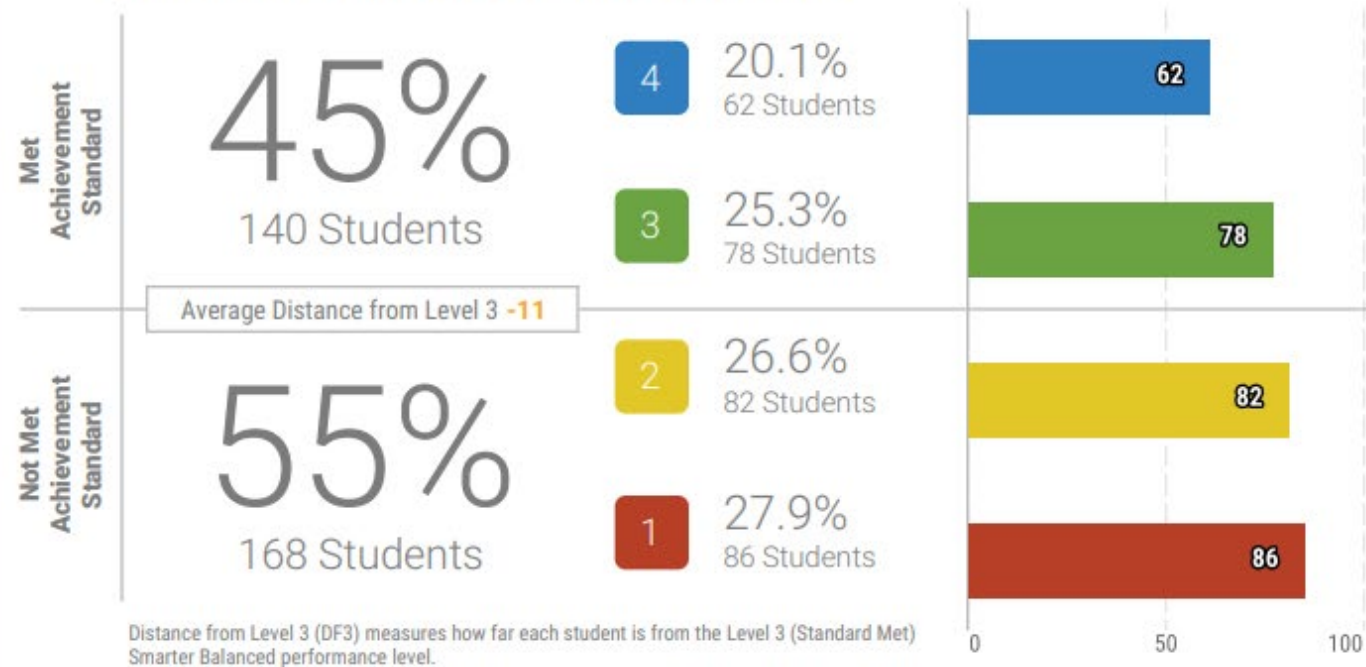

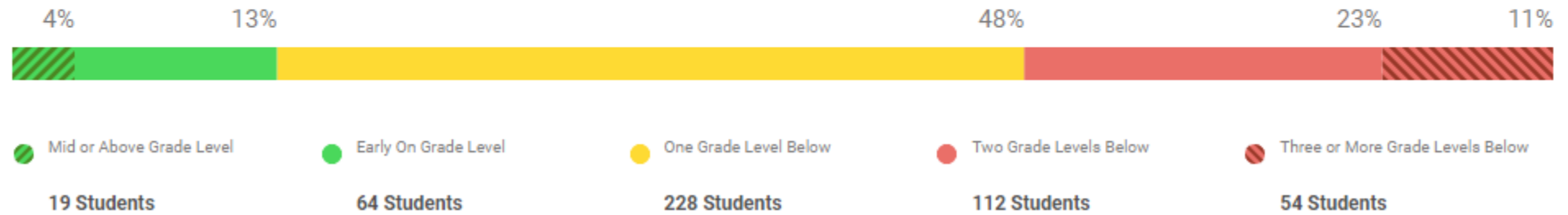

## Overall Placement

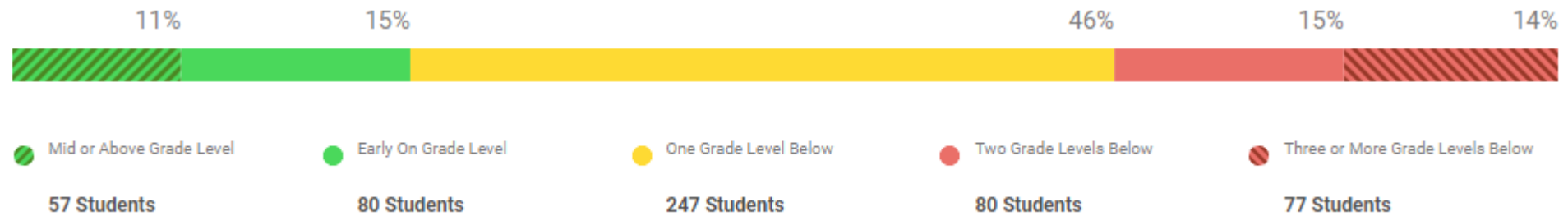
Students Assessed/Total: 477/554



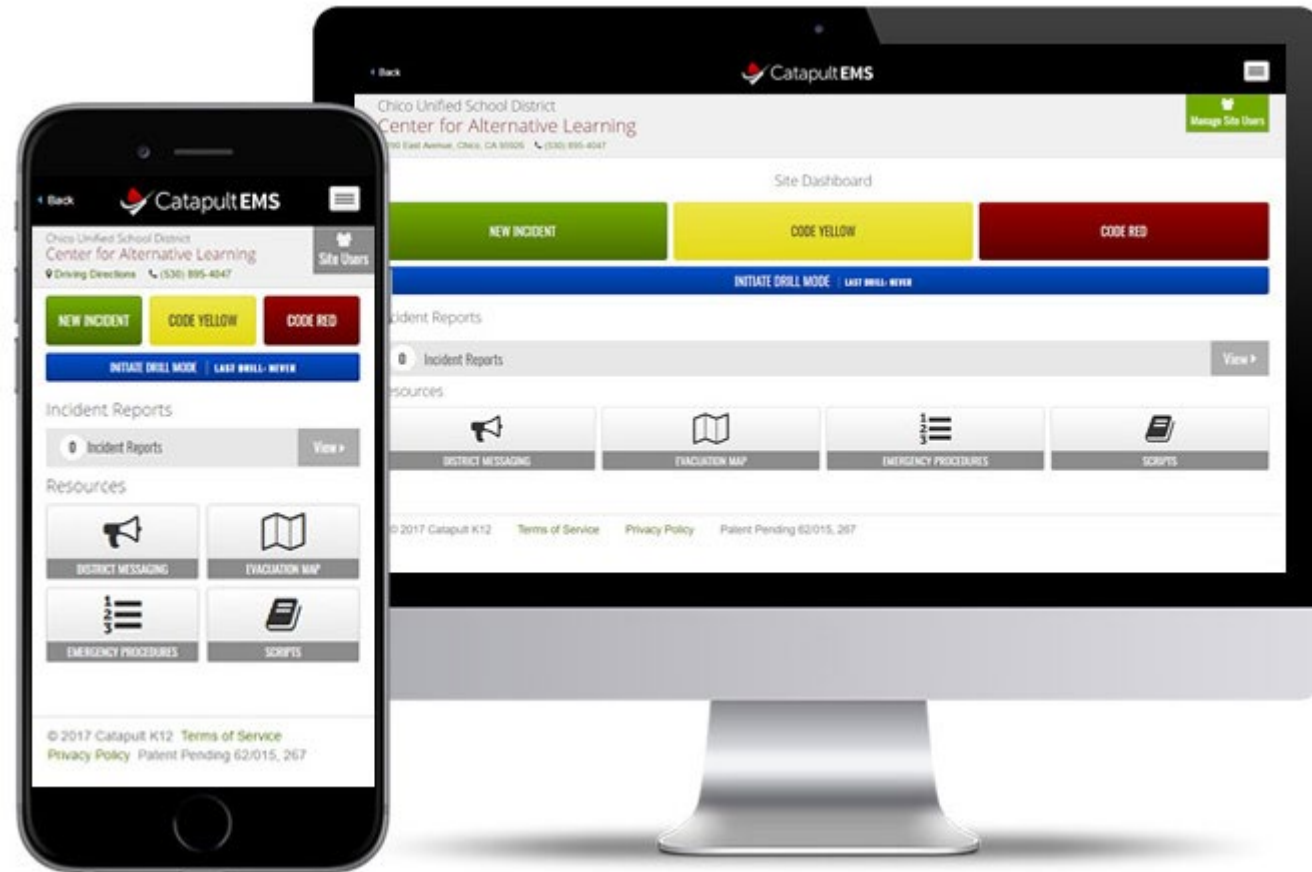
# iReady Data- ELA

# Student behavior- rude v. mean v. bullying

**IS IT BULLYING?**

When someone says or does something *unintentionally* hurtful and they do it once, that's

**RUDE**

When someone says or does something *intentionally* hurtful and they do it once, that's

**MEAN**

When someone says or does something *intentionally* hurtful and they *keep doing it* - even when you tell them to stop or show them that you're upset, that's

**BULLYING**

# Student behavior- “self-defense”

- Any student involved in a physical behavior will receive appropriate consequences.
- Self-defense is defined as an inability to get away and there is no adult present.
  - At Miramonte there is ALWAYS an adult nearby.
- Example: in the bathroom, student is followed into a stall and pushed into the corner. The only way to get out is to shove the aggressor away
- Non-example: Playing on the grass at recess, and student gets hit. Student hits back
